- vi) Municipality of East Ferris advocating for the Province of Ontario to address the child care workforce shortage in Ontario my increasing the \$18/hr minimum wage and providing benefits to RECE's in licensed child care centres.
- vii) Township of Perry supporting the position of the Municipality of Brighton regarding changes to be made to the Healthcare Connect System for Members of the Canadian Armed Forces.
- viii) Dorion Township requesting OMAFRA review the administration fee provided to municipalities for the administration of the Ontario Wildlife Compensation Program which provides compensation to farm producers for livestock killed by wildlife.
- ix) Township of King advising of its position regarding Bill 23 proposed More Homes Built Faster Act.
- x) Municipality of Huron Shores advising of its opposition to Bill 3, an Act to amend various statutes with respect to special powers and duties of heads of council.
- xi) Township of Puslinch advising it has significant concerns with proposed Bill 23, More Homes Built Faster Act 2022
