BYLAW NUMBER 2024-0024 (AD-1)

BEING A BYLAW TO APPOINT HEARING OFFICERS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE MONETARY PENALTY SYSTEM WITHIN THE TOWN OF GEORGINA

WHEREAS Section 102.1(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended ("*Municipal Act, 2001*") provides that a municipality may require a person to pay an administrative penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person failed to comply with any by-laws respecting the parking, standing or stopping of vehicles;

AND WHEREAS the Province has adopted O. Reg. 333/07 (the "Regulation") pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, which applies to administrative penalties in respect of the Town of Georgina's by-laws relating to issues of public safety, such as the parking, standing or stopping of vehicles;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the Town of Georgina has enacted an Administrative Penalty By-law;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the aforesaid by-law and the Regulation, a person who receives a Penalty Notice shall have the right to request a screening review of the administrative penalty by a Screening Officer appointed by the Town of Georgina;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the aforesaid by-law and the Regulation, a person who receives a Screening Decision shall have the right to request a review of the decision by a Hearing Officer appointed by the Town of Georgina;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Georgina considers it desirable and necessary to establish the positions of Screening Officer and Hearing Officer, which are required for the operation of the Town's Administrative Penalty By-law;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GEORGINA:

THAT the following individuals are appointed as Hearing Officers for the purpose of adjudicating Administrative Monetary Penalties:
