1. Property Standards Appeal 22-3672

Owner - Jose Soares & Giovanna Simone, located at 57 Scotia Road, Sutton.

Requesting appeal for Property Standards Order issued for "57 Scotia Road".

Jose Soares spoke about the outdated by-laws and states he would like the section in the Property Standards By-law, Schedule F Section 2.2 regarding lights to have the same consideration as the Noise By-law stating he can have his light on and off at a certain times. Jose states the picture taken by the property standards officer does not show light reflecting on the neighbouring houses.

Property Standards Officer, Jeremy Rotscholl reads his notes from the inspection conducted on September 8th, 2022.

Committee offers a possible solution to the appellant. Committee and Jose Soares go back and forth with solutions on how to fix the intrusive lights.
