**Subject:** Old Shiloh Bridge Replacement – Road Closure and Investigations

**Briefing:**

The Old Shiloh Bridge Replacement project involves replacing the existing single-lane concrete arch bridge with a new two-lane structure. The field investigations will support the preliminary design phase of the project. The Town's engineering consultant will be conducting field investigations from October to December 2024. These field investigations include environmental surveys, legal and topographic surveys, and soils investigations. The construction of the new bridge is expected to occur in late 2025.

To complete the soils investigations, boreholes must be drilled close to the existing bridge. In order to provide a safe working area for the drill rig and workers, the road must be closed for 2-3 days. Advanced signage will be posted to confirm the exact dates of the closure. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained. Relevant stakeholders such as school boards, emergency services, and waste pick up will be notified in advance.
