Details of Incident,

I was cutting my grass on Aug 4th around 1:00 pm. I recall two women and a dog walking towards me on the street (Blue Jay Blvd). I stopped the lawn mower as they were about 10 feet away and didn't want a rock or stick to be fired out. They waved and continued on and I continued with my lawn. A couple of minutes later I noticed something happening down the street. I looked up to see the two women and their dog as well as Lincoln all on the street. Lincoln was unleashed and turning away from the women and walking back towards 57 Blue Jay and I did not see Lincoln's owners. At the time it seemed harmless enough as Lincoln often charges out at people on the street. I have had to pick up my 20 lb Bichon/Shih Tzu numerous times to the point where I now just pick him up whenever I walk past Lincoln and 57 Blue Jay.

A few hours later I read a Facebook post from one of the women (Dani) involved detailing that she had been attacked by Lincoln and I decided to reach out and provide this letter and the video of it from my cameras in an effort to make it stop. The Facebook post surprised me at the number of people commenting that they have had similar experiences walking by 57 Blue Jay.
