**BYLAW NUMBER 2025-0014 (LI-3)**

BEING A BYLAW TO FURTHER AMEND BYLAW NO. 2004-0130 (LI-3), A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF DOGS WITHIN THE TOWN OF GEORGINA

---

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Georgina may, pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, pass bylaws in reference to animals kept within the municipality;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GEORGINA:

1. THAT Bylaw No. 2004-0130 (LI-3), as amended, be further amended by rewording the definition of “running at large” contained in Section 1 thereof to read as follows:

“running at large”, when used in reference to a dog or cat, shall mean that such dog or cat has been found in any place other than the premises of the owner, not under the control of any person, and not on a leash.
