**Subject: Character Reference and Appeal Regarding the Temperament of Chewy**

Dear Members of the Appeal Committee,

I am writing this letter as a direct neighbor and long-term acquaintance of Tim, the owner of the dog in question, Chewy. I understand that Chewy's status is currently under review, and I wish to provide an unequivocal character reference for his temperament, which I can attest is neither aggressive nor dangerous.


